A small, family owned house in Epernay since 1862. Full, fruity and smooth and produced from black grapes.
- 31 Vincent Testulat Rosé** **29.95**
Delicious, soft, cherry fruit from this old Epernay house. Pinot Noir grapes give the fragrance and cherry flavours.
- 32 Moët et Chandon Brut Imperial** **36.95**
Delicate and floral on the nose, this Champagne is the most famous label, founded in 1743.

Soft and creamy with a persistent mousse and a long finish. A superb quality Champagne.
- 34 Deutz Brut Classic** **39.95**

3	Viognier 'Y Series' Yalumba - Australia A delicious wine from arguably the best Viognier producer in the New World. Soft, smooth, peachy and fabulous.	15.95
4	Chardonnay Casa Lapostolle - Chile A smooth, flavoursome, gently oaked wine from the Marnier-Lapostolle family, of Grand Marnier fame.	16.50
5	Sauvignon Blanc Coopers Creek - New Zealand A citrusy Sauvignon from one of Marlborough's best wineries. Aromatic and pungent with plenty of flavour.	17.95
